TYPE/BENEFITS AND DUES:

All memberships begin on the day it is purchased and is valid for 365 days.

INDIVIDUAL (BASIC):

This membership type is open to individuals in the categories defined. It includes access to webinars and training, the NASOMH e-newsletter, an electronic database of State Office of Minority Health directors and contacts, and website access to career and job postings.

- Student membership (\$50.00) is open to undergraduate and graduate students interested in minority health, health equity, and eliminating racial and ethnic health disparities. This membership does not have voting rights.
- Associate membership (\$100.00) is open to any individual of an organization that supports the mission of NASOMH. This membership has voting rights.

STATE AND TERRITORIAL OFFICES OR ENTITIES

This membership type includes eligibility for nomination to the NASOMH Board; regular voting membership on all matters before NASOMH; access to the NASOMH President; waived registration to in-person membership meetings; advocacy with U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Minority Health, and Regional Health Equity Officers; grant guidance; technical assistance for office sustainability, and educating legislators on the vitality and value of State Offices of Minority Health and Health Equity; access to free webinars, and virtual training with NASOMH partners; addition to state profiles; career/job board posting privileges, NASOMH e newsletter, and website access.

ASSOCIATION

This membership type is designed for organizations with 50 or fewer employees interested in minority health, health equity, and eliminating racial and ethnic health disparities. This membership includes all benefits of individual membership in addition to express access to the NASOMH President, waived registration to in-person membership meetings, advocacy with HHS/OMH and Regional Health Equity Officers, and webinars on best practices. This membership has voting rights on some matters before NASOMH.

INSTITUTIONAL

Institutional membership is designed for larger organizations that support the mission of NASOMH. This membership type includes all benefits of individual membership in addition to express access to the NASOMH President, waived registration to in-person membership meetings, advocacy with HHS/OMH and Regional Health Equity Officers, webinars on best practices, use of the NASOMH logo as a partnership, and career/job board posting privileges. This membership has voting rights on some matters before NASOMH.
